PROTECTING YOUR LAND WITH A CONSERVATION EASEMENT

A conservation easement is a voluntary agreement between the landowner (that's you!) and the land trust (that's us!) that constrains allowable uses of the land.



Under a conservation easement, you retain ownership of and title to your land. You may continue to live on it, sell it, or pass it on to your heirs knowing that it will always be protected.



Conservation easements are flexible agreements—negotiated with you—to make sure that your conservation goals are met and that the natural features of your land are protected.



Conservation easements are permanent. They will always stay with the land, no matter how many times it changes ownership.

Ellie's Story

When we first met with the now late, Eleanor “Ellie” Abbott to discuss placing an easement on her 27 acres of land along Lake Michigan, she had endless stories to share.

As she recalled climbing the hills and sitting on a favorite perch she called “Inspiration Point” (pictured above), we asked how long she had been connected to the property. She quickly replied “My whole life. In fact, I was conceived here!”

Ellie wanted to make sure that the forested portion of the bluff and the gorges were protected, so she asked Ozaukee Washington Land Trust to help structure a conservation easement that would protect the most sensitive areas of the property.

In doing so, the Abbott family has created a living museum along Lake Michigan that will protect important habitat and serve as a significant migratory stopover for wildlife.
